He has worked with theatre companies and organizations such as Broadway Advocacy Coalition, Columbia University's Center For Institutional and Social Change, Out of the Box Theatrics, Misi Productions, and Teatro SEA, and has served in the Board of Directors at The Phoenix Theatre (PA), Proscaenium Theatre Company and Arts Culture Jawn.

Andrés is the founder of Cumbres Musical in Colombia, a preprofessional theatre program. He is also part of the founders of C.R.E.A. Collaborate to Reimagine and Evolve the Arts in New York City.

As a director, he has worked on numerous theatrical productions both Off-Broadway and Regionally — including theaters such as the Davenport Theatre, the Kraine Theater, and the American Theatre of Actors, among others. His work as a creator has extended to numerous mediums beyond the theatre, including choreography and film direction.
